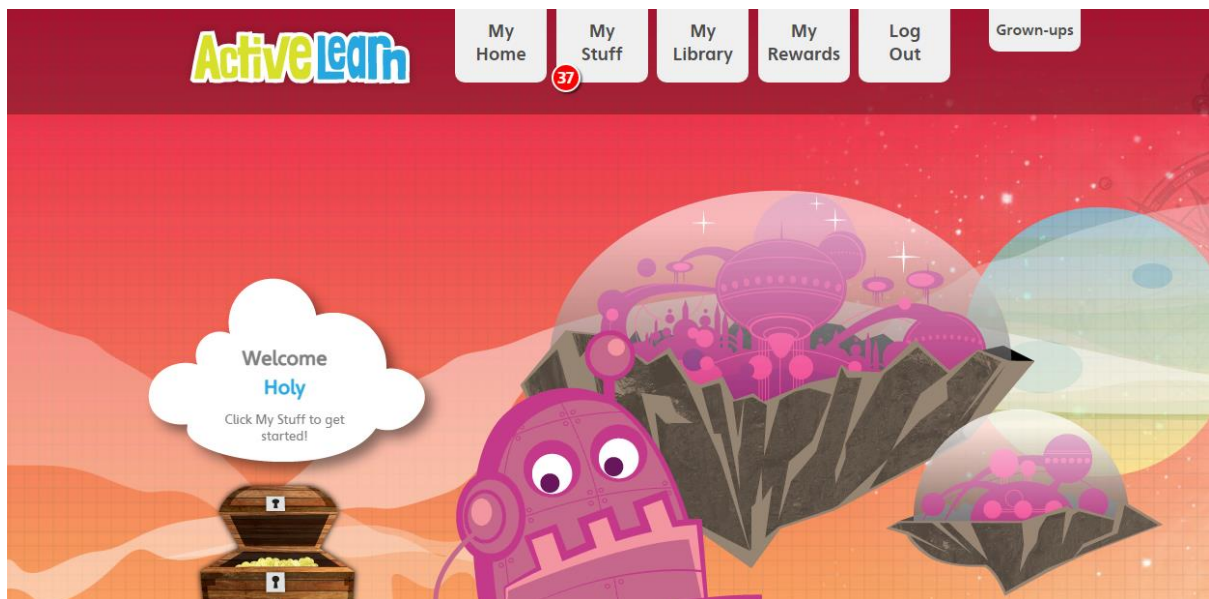

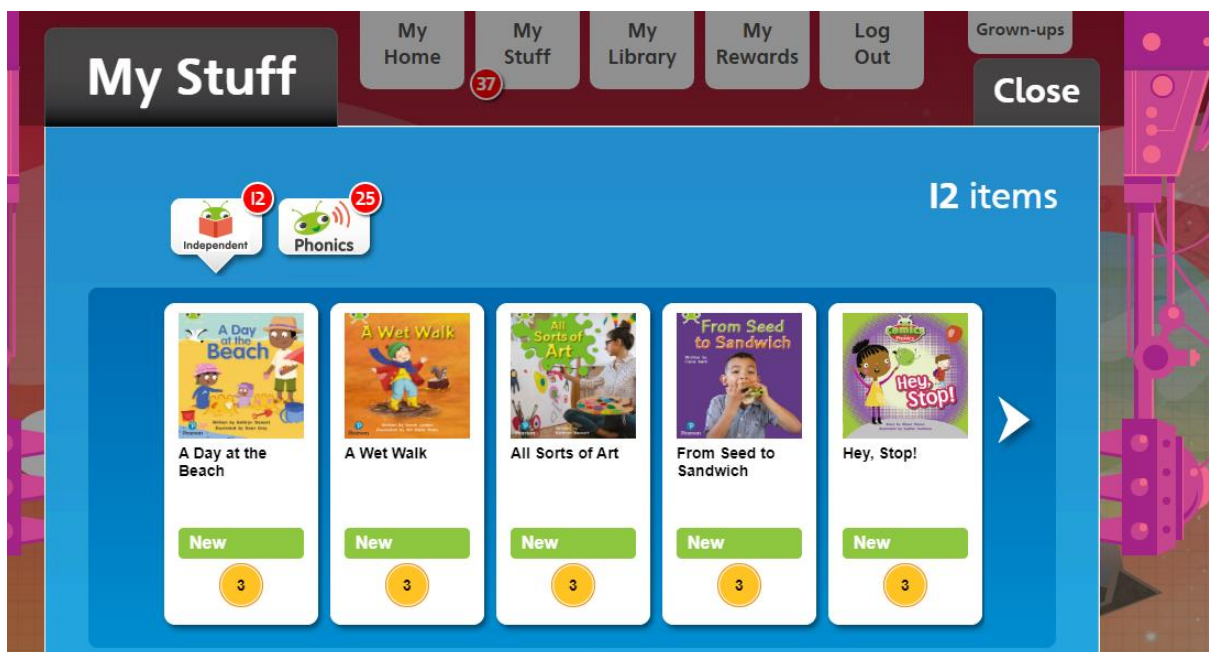

This will take you to your child's homepage. They can change the home screen by going to 'my home'. They can choose bug world, race, skate or future world. To read a book and earn points, visit the 'My Stuff' tab.



You can now choose a book by clicking on the one your child would like to read.



At the bottom of each book, you can see a gold coin and a number. This shows how many coins your child will be rewarded for completing the quiz activity and reading to the end of the book.

Your child's teacher may have set **phonics games**, which matches their learning in school. These can be found under the 'My Stuff' tab, under phonics.

Phonic games may have been allocated and can be found here



As with the eBooks, the gold coin represents how many coins the child will get as a reward for completing the game.



Whenever you open a game the first step is to click the play button and the narrator will provide the instructions for the game. You can also click the Guide button at the top right of the screen for written instructions.

In every game your child will have 3 chances to answer each question. If they get all three wrong, the narrator will provide the correct answer.

You can see how you did in the score counter. A green hexagon is shown for each question answered correctly and a red hexagon is shown for each answered incorrectly.

When you click on the 'My Library' tab, you will find books that your child has read, which can be accessed again. Your child will not earn additional coins for re-reading a book.



Click on the bugs to reveal the question.



Under the 'My Rewards' tab, children can play games and choose how to spend their rewards. Over time, your child will accumulate more and more coins as they read more and more Bug Club Phonics books. You can see just how many coins they have on the homepage. Now for their favourite part (after reading the eBooks of course), spending those coins. Click on My Rewards to spend the coins. In the **Pit Stop** area children can play a racing game; in the Sticker Factory area they can buy digital stickers; finally, in The Tree House, they can decorate their tree house.



In the 'Grown-ups' area there are some top tips on how you can help your child read from home.
