<p>Research the work of artists in Poole and/or Cherbourg. Sketch their sculptures/art work and label the elements of art involved.</p>	<p>Design a map of the world labelling all of the continents and oceans in an artistic manner.</p>	<p>Create a piece of artwork using at least 4 different mediums.</p>
