

Claws, paws and more!

Year 1 Home Learning Project – Children can choose one (or more) project to work on over the next two weeks to consolidate their learning on our topic 'Claws, paws or more'. Below are a few suggestions to give you some inspiration for your project.

Draw a map of your route to school including human and physical features. Can you make a simple key?	Make an eco-friendly habitat in your garden for animals e.g. bird house/feeder, bug hotel, hedgehog house. Take a photo to bring in.	Make a model of your favourite animal (e.g. clay, junk modelling, Lego) Can you label it or write a fact?
Go on an animal hunt. Take photos or draw pictures of what you found or even make a tally chart of mammals/reptiles/birds/amphibians/fish/insects.	Make a poster of physical (beach, forest, rec) and human (shops, house, school) features in your local area. Can you add labels?	Research information about an animal of your choice and create your own mini fact file. Can you add pictures/photographs?

There is no expectation that children will complete all the tasks, these are just ideas for the children to work on. Projects are due in on **Monday 13th July**.

The children will have the opportunity to share their projects throughout the week and Year 1 parents will be invited in on **Friday 17th July at 3pm** to view the projects across the classes.
